Mrs T Dillon updated the members on the last meeting with Safer Community Council on 21 July 2009. The meeting concentrated mainly on the SWDC Contract Services which had to be accepted by Council. Mayor Neil Sinclair advised that had now been signed.

The Gambling Sub-Committee had been formed and there was going to be a Promotional week from 1 September 2009. Promotional material had been obtained and will be placed in windows around Tokoroa, Putaruru and Tirau.

Mrs Dillon thought the committee were listening to advice and it looked as though they were on track and felt they would succeed in what they were trying to do.

Mrs Dillon asked members if they were interested in Kelvin Hainsworth attending a meeting to talk on the River Trail. Mrs Martelletti to arrange.

Mr May asked about the RiskPool call on funds that is on the Council agenda for Thursday. Mr Morris advised that he made Council aware immediately and on Thursday it would be the first time to discuss it at a public meeting. Even if Council bailed they are still liable and he sees that in the future we are quite vulnerable but going forward carrying on with Risk Pool may be the best option.

Mayor Neil Sinclair excused himself at 7.55pm

Meeting was adjourned at 7.55 pm to receive a presentation from Sergeant Jason Shailer of Putaruru Police. Sergeant Shailer went through a power point presentation which outlined the staffing of the Putaruru station and then the stats for the 2007-08 year which showed a drop in crime (141 offences). Cr J Shattock asked if the cameras had any significant impact. Sergeant Shailer advised they solved the odd crime but were more of a deterrent, people cannot get in and out of town without passing a camera. The 2008-09 year there was a gain in crime (157 offences). Sergeant Shailer said this was mainly Family Violence which was a good thing as people are more aware and are reporting incidences.

Discussion was held about Tirau – no-one around. Cr Shattock asked if Camera's would help. Sergeant Shailer thought that a Security Guard at night time would put a mobile patrol and give "eyes" out into the community. Perhaps the Tirau Business Association could fund – minimal cost per week per business. Cr J Shattock advised that there are grants available.

Cr Barker asked about Rural Support Groups. Sergeant Shailer advised the challenge was to keep people interested. Email chains have worked well. Strong groups around.

Discussion was held about the State Highway 1/5 Intersection.

Sergeant Shailer mentioned that in Putaruru the local house rental agents work with the Police to do informal Police checks on people who come into the district.

Youth is always a priority. Sergeant Shailer advised that they were onto the Youth activities. They work with the families. Alcohol was the main problem and it wont go away.

For Tirau the challenge is to reduce vulnerability as much as possible and this could be done in the form of a Security Guard and Neighbourhood/Rural Patrols.

Discussion was had about "P" in the district. Sergeant Shailer said in his opinion Alcohol was the major problem. It has no comparison – "P" had major effects on body and mind as was dramatic over a short period of time. Alcohol is a long term problem.

Mr M May asked if something could be looked into about the no right entrance into Prospect Street. Couriers and others are always going that way.

Cr Shattock commented that we need to get it out there that we live in a really safe environment.

Mrs T Dillon thanked Sergeant Shailer for attending the meeting and giving a very informative presentation.

The meeting reconvened at 8.45pm

Cr E Barker commented that something needed to be done about the Public Toilets in town. The Information Centre is only open from 9am – 5pm. Three buses turned up at 8.30am and there are not the facilities open to cope. One Toilet at the Caltex for three buses is not enough. Perhaps the 'Dog' could be altered so there is access to toilets from the outside.

Cr E Barker advised the Tirau Business Association Breakfast was this Thursday at Poppy's – AGM next month looking for a new committee.
