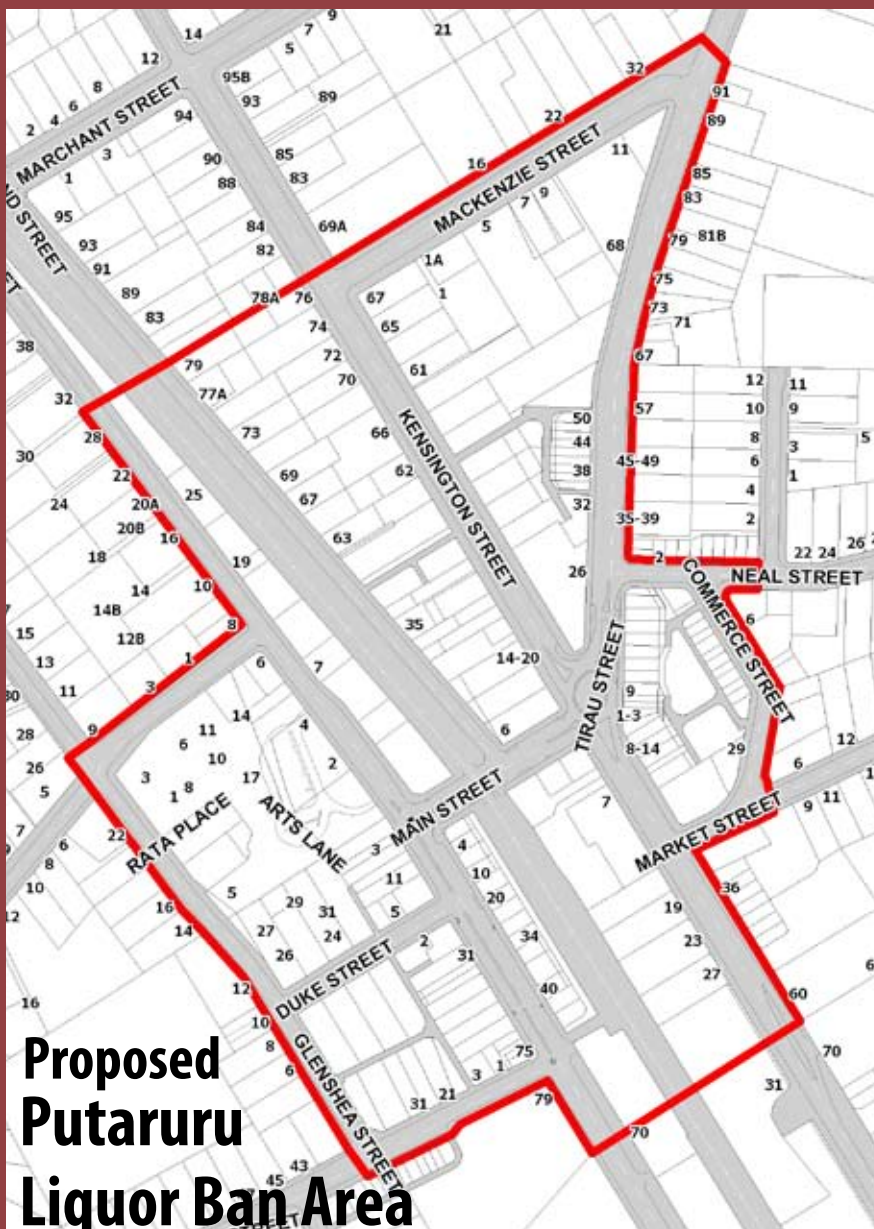
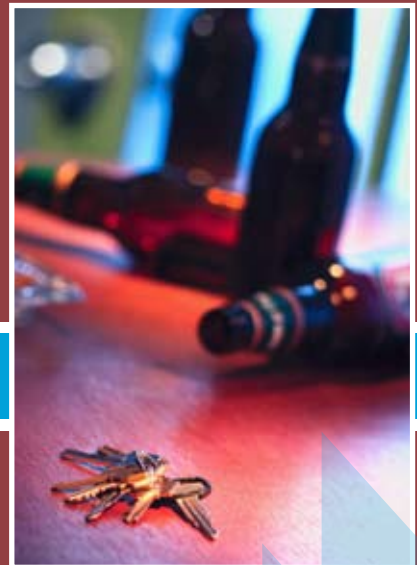


Statement of Proposal Liquor in Public Places Bylaw 2004

Putaruru Liquor Ban

Background

The Putaruru Community has expressed concern over the number of adolescents who congregate in the Putaruru CBD drinking alcohol. Reportedly, a number of citizens have felt threatened and intimidated by these incidents. Following legal advice, Council proposes to amend its existing 'Liquor in Public Places Bylaw 2004'.

Proposed Amendment

The following amendment is proposed:

'Prohibited Area' means the area within both Tokoroa and Putaruru defined in Clause 2 of the Schedule to this Bylaw.

Currently the Bylaw is exclusive to Tokoroa and reads: 'Prohibited Area' means the area within the Tokoroa Central Business District defined in ...

Additional Amendment

In reviewing the Bylaw, a numbering error was identified. Council is able to resolve minor changes on this Bylaw and has done so. However it is still required to publically notify the amendment. The numbering is corrected by the following change:

*'Defined times' be renumbered
Clause 1*

*'Prohibited areas' be renumbered
Clause 2*
