South Waikato District Council welcomes submissions on its Rates Remission and Postponement on Māori Freehold Land Policy. This Policy is open for public consultation from Wednesday 13 April 2022 and closes on Sunday 15 May 2022.

The Policy has been amended to reflect changes to Government legislation that introduces a statutory rates remission process for Māori Freehold Land under development. This change is to support regional growth by encouraging the development of under-utilised Māori Freehold Land.

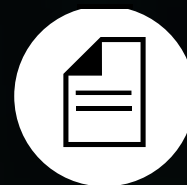
