Urban Kerblines Spraying

To help keep our towns looking tidy, Council carries out chemical kerblines spraying in our CBD, urban and residential areas - this activity controls vegetation growth over the kerblines. In the past this activity was done on an annual basis, however Council has made the decision to increase the frequency of this spraying for better maintenance. The next spraying will occur during the months of October and November. As per usual, if you wish to maintain the kerblines in front of your property yourself, without the assistance of Council's chemical spraying, all you need to do is let us know.
