# Roads Closed to Ordinary Vehicular Traffic - Tokoroa Christmas Parade 2018

Pursuant to Schedule 10 of the Local Government Act 1974, South Waikato District Council, for the purpose of the holding of the TOKOROA CITY LIONS CLUB CHRISTMAS PARADE 2018, advises that the following roads will be closed to ordinary vehicular traffic for the period indicated hereunder.

Roads in Tokoroa closed to ordinary vehicular traffic on Saturday, 8 December 2018 from 8.00am to 12 noon:

- Kindergarten Street.
- Mannering Street from Bridge Street northwards to the Tokoroa Library.
- Leith Place Central between Bridge and Logan Streets.

Please also note that no parking of vehicles will be allowed from 7.00am to 12.00 noon on the northern side of Bridge Street between its intersection with Bonaly Street and Leith Place Central, and on Clyde Street adjacent to Kindergarten Street.
