



## CASUAL CAMPING IN THE SOUTH WAIKATO

The South Waikato has several beautiful reserves that are ideal for Casual Camping. Located in the central North Island our reserves not only boast stunning scenery, they also offer a range of basic facilities for freedom campers, and grey water disposal sites are available in all three of our towns.

All of our reserves are within a short distance of many other attractions within the South Waikato, such as Te Waihou Walkway and Blue Spring, the Waikato River Trails, Lake Moananui, South Waikato Indoor Pools, and so much more!

With so much to see and do, the South Waikato is the perfect destination for Casual Camping this summer.

## CASUAL CAMPING SITES

Self-contained caravans and campervans can stay at any site for up to two nights without a permit. Stays longer than two nights require a permit.

Camping in tents and vehicles requires a camping permit at all times.

## OVERNIGHT PARKING SITES

Camping in overnight parking sites by self-contained campervans and motor homes only, for a maximum of two nights in any calendar month.

## PERMITS

Permits are required for Casual Camping in the South Waikato. Permits are free of charge and to obtain one all you need to do is stop in to one of the South Waikato District Council offices, located in Tokoroa and Putāruru, or the South Waikato District i-SITES and ask the friendly Customer Services Officers for a Casual Camping Permit.

Permits are valid for a period of four weeks (28 days) in total and one permit covers one vehicle at a camping site (maximum of six people can be covered by a permit).

Overnight parking does not require a permit and is limited to the reserves indicated. All vehicles parking overnight must be fitted with a minimum three days toilet and grey water capacity and all rubbish must be removed from the site on departure.

There are public toilets located at each reserve.
