THE APPLICATION

THE REASONS FOR THE DECISON

The Inspector has provided a report on the application and believes the application meets the criteria for issue.

The club has been granted special licences in the past for similar functions and these have not created any issues for the regulatory agencies or neighbours.

An exemption under Section 213(2) vis sought to allow non-certificated managers to oversee the events. The exemption is granted, and a responsible person will be overseeing the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol at each event.

Neither the reports of the Police nor that of the Medical Officer of Health raises any matters in opposition.

I am satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act.

DECISION

The District Licensing Committee, pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 grants the application by **Tokoroa Kart Club Incorporated** for an on-site Special Licence in respect of premises situated at Moffatt Road known as the <u>STIHL</u> <u>SHOP TOKOROA RACEWAY</u> subject to conditions.

Conditions:

The licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold and supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:

- 2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises;
- 3. A responsible person, nominated by the licensee, must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol;
- 4. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence or menu variations of a similar range and standard;
- 5. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages;
- 6. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
 - a. At every point of sale detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
 - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
- 7. The licensee must provide information and advice about forms of transport available to patrons from the licensed premises.
- 8. No BYO alcohol is to be brought into the events.
