THE APPLICATION

Tokoroa Youth Boxing Club Incorporated applies for an on-site known as the South Waikato Sports & Events centre for a fundraiser Boxing Fight Night.

Up to 650 persons are expected to attend and this is the fourth time this event has been run.

The day and hours sought are:

Saturday 15 May 2021 5.00pm to 10.15pm.

Substantive food and low alcohol and non-alcoholic beverages will be available at all times.

Two certificated managers will oversee the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.

A AMP has been prepared for the event and licensed security will be overseeing the crowd behaviour.

THE REASONS FOR THE DECISON

The Inspector has provided a report on the application and believes the application meets the criteria for issue.

The club has been granted special licences in the past for similar functions and these have not created any issues for the regulatory agencies or neighbours.

A certificated manager will also be overseeing the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol at each event.

Neither the reports of the Police nor that of the Medical Officer of Health raises any matters in opposition.

I am satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act.

DECISION

The District Licensing Committee, pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 grants the application by <u>TOKOROA YOUTH BOXING CLUB INCORPORATED</u> for an on-site Special Licence known as the South Waikato Sports & Events Centre subject to conditions.

Conditions:

The licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold and supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:

Saturday 15 May 2021 5.00pm to 10.15pm;

- 2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises;
- 3. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol;
- 4. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence or menu variations of a similar range and standard;

- 5. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages;
- 6. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
 - a. At every point of sale detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
 - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
- 7. The licensee must provide information and advice about forms of transport available to patrons from the licensed premises.
- 8. No BYO alcohol is to be brought into the events.
- 9. The whole of the premises is designated as a Restricted Area;
- 10. A maximum of two alcoholic drinks per person per sale applies at all times.
- 11. The AMP provided must be followed at all times.
