This is an application by **TWENTY NINE FOUNDERS LIMITED for a Temporary Authority for premises situated at 38 Bridge Street, Tokoroa and currently known as "<u>NEXUS WINE & CAFE**."</u>

The business is a tavern and gaming venue and an ON Licence, 17/ON/014/2020, is operative at the premises and expired on the 26<sup>th</sup> of November 2020. A renewal application has been lodged to keep the base licence 'live' for this transition process.

The application contains supporting documentary evidence showing a sale and purchase agreement and there are reports from the Police and the Inspector that do not raise any matters in opposition.

## **REASONS FOR THE DECISION**

Neither the New Zealand Police nor the Licensing Inspector oppose the granting of the order.

The applicant appears to be an experienced hospitality operator and is aware of their responsibilities.

Accordingly, the application will be dealt with by the committee on the papers.

# DECISION

The application and supporting information satisfies us that the criteria we must have regard to, as set out in s.136 of the Act, has been met.

The District Licensing Committee, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 makes an order for a Temporary Authority to **TWENTY NINE FOUNDERS LIMITED** and it can be issued immediately.

The conditions attached to ON LICENCE 17/ON/014/2020 shall continue to apply.

Applications for planning and building certificates and the substantive ON Licence must be lodged promptly.

The Order is to run for <u>3 months from the 14<sup>th</sup> day of May 2021</u>
