The Application

TRIO (WAIKATO) LIMITED applies for the grant of an ON Licence in respect of premises situated at 202 Lake Road, Okoroire, Tirau to be known as **'NOURISHED BY TRIO'**.

The business plans to operate as a low-risk function centre catering for weddings and events on site and catering for events off site.

The applicant seeks a Section 38 caterers' endorsement. They apply for a Section 37 BYO endorsement in error as such endorsements are granted to BYO ONLY premises.

They have also applied for an OFF Licence to facilitate a food hamper business that they previously operated in the Auckland region. Section 35 of the Act specifically prohibits the grant of an off licence for a 'shop' where the principal business is the sale of food. The OFF Licence will not be considered at this time.

The application was publicly notified on councils' website from the 26th of February 2025. No objections were received from members of the public.

The days and hours sought are **Monday to Sunday 11.00am to 11.00pm.**

The applicant has provided a detailed menu of the food options they sell and the low alcohol and non-alcoholic refreshments that are available.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

Neither the Police nor the Medical Officer of Health has raised any matters in opposition.

The Inspector reports that the amenity and good order of the area should not be reduced by more than a minor extent by the operation of this licence.

Overall, I am satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.105, 106 and 38 of the Act.

I am satisfied that they intend to operate as a caterer for **on-site** consumption at venues and the home venue.

Accordingly, I deal with the matter on the papers.

DECISION

The District Licensing Committee Chairman, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **grants** an application by **TRIO (WAIKATO) LIMITED** for an ON Licence in respect of premises situated at 202 Lake Road, Okoroire, Tirau to be known as **'NOURISHED BY TRIO'** subject to conditions.

The Licence is valid for 12 months from the date of issue.

The Licence to be endorsed "Section 38 applies"

Conditions:

The following conditions apply at every venue at which the licensee sells or supplies alcohol pursuant to this licence:

1. Alcohol may be sold or supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:
Monday to Sunday 11.00am to 11.00pm;
2. No alcohol is to be sold or supplied on the Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1pm on Anzac Day to any person other than a person who is on the premises to dine;

3. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
4. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
5. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises is open for the sale and supply of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence or menu variations of a similar range and standard. Menus must be visible, and food should be actively promoted;
6. **A properly appointed certificated, or Acting or Temporary, manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed in the premises;**
7. The licensee must provide information, advice and assistance about alternative forms of transport available to patrons from the licensed premises;
8. The Licensee must display:
 - a. At every point of sale, signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
 - b. At the principal entrance to the premises, so as to be easily read by people immediately outside the premises, a sign stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises will be open for sale of alcohol;
 - c. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises;
