**THE APPLICATION**

**Robyn Gwylfa MOODY** (“the licensee”) applies for an on-site Special Licence in respect of premises situated at 25 Mossop Road, Tokoroa known as the ‘**SOUTH WAIKATO EVENTS CENTRE**’.

The occasion is the wedding reception for the Fuapah/Dehar union. Up to 50 family members and guests are expected to attend.

**Saturday 19 July 2025 11.00am to 5.00pm.**

Substantive food and low alcohol and non-alcoholic beverages will be available at all times.

A certificated manager will oversee the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.

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## **THE REASONS FOR THE DECISION**

The Inspector has provided a report on the application and believes the application meets the criteria for issue.

Neither the Police nor the Medical Officer of Health have raised any matters in opposition.

I am satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act.

## **DECISION**

The District Licensing Committee, pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 **grants** the application by **Robyn Gwylfa MOODY** (“the licensee”) for an on-site Special Licence in respect of premises situated at 25 Mossop Road, Tokoroa known as the ‘**SOUTH WAIKATO EVENTS CENTRE**’ subject to conditions.

### **Conditions:**

The licence is subject to the following conditions:

The issue of the licence in addition to the prescribed conditions of operation shall be subject to the following discretionary conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold and supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:

**Saturday 19 July 2025 11.00am to 5.00pm.**

2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
  3. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol.
  4. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence or menu variations of a similar range and standard.
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5. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
6. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
  - a. At every point-of-sale detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
  - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
  - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the for the time being on duty.
7. The licensee must provide information and advice about alternative forms of transport available to patrons from the licensed premises.
8. No BYO alcohol is to be brought into this event.
