The Application

FUSION ENTERPRISES LIMITED applies for the grant of an ON Licence in respect of premises situated at 31B Main Road, Tirau known as **'TUCKER BAR & EATERY'**.

The business is a Class 3 low risk restaurant and cafe.

The application was publicly notified on councils' website from the 8th of August 2025. No objections were received from members of the public.

The current days and hours are:

Sunday to Thursday 9.00am to 3.00pm
Friday to Saturday 9.00am to 9.00pm

The applicant has provided a detailed menu of the food options they sell and the low alcohol and non-alcoholic refreshments that are available.

The food is prepared on site, and the inspector advises that it is of an acceptable variety and can be provided within a reasonable time of placing an order.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

Neither the Police nor the Medical Officer of Health has raised any **final** matters in opposition now that the hours have been reduced and adequate numbers of certificated managers are appointed to the business.

The Inspector reports that the amenity and good order of the area should not be reduced by more than a minor extent.

Overall, I am satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.105 and 106 of the Act.

Accordingly, I deal with the matter on the papers.

DECISION

The District Licensing Committee Chairman, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **grants** an application by **FUSION ENTERPRISES LIMITED** for an ON Licence in respect of premises situated at 31B Main Road, Tirau known as **'TUCKER BAR & EATERY'** subject to conditions.

Conditions:

The licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold or supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:

Sunday to Thursday 9.00am to 3.00pm

Friday to Saturday 9.00am to 9.00pm

2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
3. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
4. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises is open for the sale and supply of alcohol, in accordance with

the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence or menu variations of a similar range and standard. Menus must be visible, and food should be actively promoted;

5. **A properly appointed certificated, or Acting or Temporary, manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed in the premises;**
6. The licensee must provide information, advice and assistance about alternative forms of transport available to patrons from the licensed premises;
7. The Licensee must display:
 - a. At every point of sale, signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
 - b. At the principal entrance to the premises, so as to be easily read by people immediately outside the premises, a sign stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises will be open for sale of alcohol;
 - c. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises;

The licence is granted for 12 months from the date of issue.
