THE APPLICATION

NDURO EVENTS 2014 LIMITED applies for an on-site Special Licence in respect of premises situated on Mossop Road, Tokoroa, known as the '**TOKOROA MEMORIAL SPORTS GROUND FIELDS 10 & 11**'.

This low-risk event is the **2026 Volcanic Epic MTB Stage Race** and up to 300 persons are extended to attend.

The day and hours sought are:

Saturday 26 March 2026 – 10.00am to 3.00pm

Substantive food and low alcohol and non-alcoholic beverages will be available at all times.

A certificated manager will oversee the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.

THE REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The Inspector has provided a report on the application and believes the application meets the criteria for issue.

Neither the reports of the Police nor that of the Medical Officer of Health raises any matters in opposition.

I am satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act.

DECISION

The District Licensing Committee, pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 **grants** the application by **NDURO EVENTS 2014 LIMITED** for an on-site Special Licence in respect of premises situated on Mossop Road, Tokoroa, known as the **'TOKOROA MEMORIAL SPORTS GROUND'** subject to conditions.

Conditions:

The licence is subject to the following conditions:

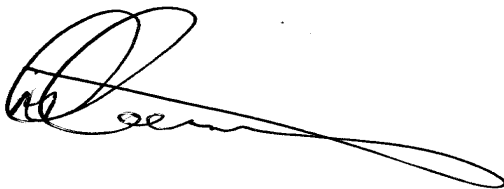
1. Alcohol may be sold and supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:

Saturday 26 March 2026 – 10.00am to 3.00pm;

2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises;
 3. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol;
 4. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence or menu variations of a similar range and standard;
 5. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages;
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6. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
 - a. At every point of sale detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
 - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
7. The licensee must provide information and advice about alternative forms of transport available to patrons from the licensed premises.
8. No BYO alcohol is to be brought into the event.
9. A maximum of 2 alcoholic drinks per sale, per persons, is permitted and drinks must be supplied in paper cups as per the AMP.
10. The applicant must comply with the provisions in the Alcohol Management Plan (AMP) submitted with the application.
