The Licensing Inspector has provided a report outlining the applicant's suitability and experience.

Neither the New Zealand Police nor the Licensing Inspector express any concern about the suitability of the applicant nor do they oppose the granting of the application.

Ms Karauna has held her manager's licence for seven years and it is reasonable to assume that she has gained the appropriate training and experience over these years.

DECISION
