

APPLICATION 17/OFF/09/2016

IN THE MATTER of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012(The Act)

AND

THE MATTER OF an application by Moohit Roopra on behalf of Value Liquor Ltd pursuant to s100 of the Act for an Off Licence in respect of premises situated at 27 – 29 Arapuni Street Putaruru known as Value Liquor.

THE APPLICATION:

Moohit Roopra on behalf of Value Liquor has filed an application pursuant to s.100 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 for an OFF Licence in respect of premises situated at 27 – 29 Arapuni Street, Putaruru known as “Value Liquor.”

- 1) Moohit Roopra is the new director of Value Liquor Ltd.
- 2) The business is an established bottle store and the applicant has been operating under a temporary authority.
- 3) A Temporary Authority was granted on 11 may 2016.
- 4) There will be two certified managers employed.
- 5) The applicant seeks the following hours
 - 9:00am – 10:00pm
- 6) The application was publicly notified in the South Waikato News on 29th June and 6th July 2016. No objections were received.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

- 7) The application is complete and contains all the supporting documents as required under s.100 of the Act. It was duly advertised and no objection, opposition or notice of desire to be heard has been received.
- 8) The Liquor Licensing Inspector states that the premises meets the criteria of s.32(1)(b) for the kind of premises that can hold an Off-Licence due to the principal business being that of a retail premises where at least 85% of the revenue is from the sale of alcohol for consumption off the premises.
- 9) The Licensing Inspector does not oppose this application.

- 10) No report was received from the Police Section 141(5) states that if no report is received by the Police within the 15 days, then they do not oppose the application.
- 11) The Medical Officer of Health does not oppose the application.
- 12) The Fire Risk Management Officer does not oppose this application.
- 13) The premises meets the requirements of the Resource Management Act 1991
- 14) The premise meets the requirements of the Building Code.
- 15) The premises currently has a designation of a Supervised Area. This is appropriate for this type of business and is to continue
- 16) Currently the South Waikato does not have a Local Alcohol Policy.
- 17) Overall I am satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.105 and s. 131 of the Act.

DECISION

- 18) The District Licensing Committee Chairperson, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **approves** an application by Moothit Roopra on behalf of Value Liquor Ltd for an OFF Licence (17/OFF/09/2016) in respect of premises situated at 27 – 29 Arapuni Street Putaruru known as Value Liquor subject to conditions.


CONDITIONS

- 19) This licence is subject to the following conditions:
 - (a) no alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day:
 - (b) alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
 - Monday to Sunday 9.00 am to 10.00 pm
 - (c) no alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Easter Sunday unless the alcohol is grape wine or fruit or vegetable wine made—
 - (i) on the premises; or
 - (ii) from grapes or fruit harvested from land on which the premises are situated:
 - (d) The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
 - (e) While alcohol is being supplied free as a sample, water is to be provided to patrons free of charge at the place where the samples are being supplied;
 - (f) The whole of the premises is designated as a supervised area

(g) A certificated manager must be on duty within the licensed area at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol;

(h) A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from Arapuni Street, Putaruru is designated as the principal entrance.
