APPLICATION

This is an application by Celene Jade Vivienne Taylor (nee Howell) for the renewal of a manager's certificate in accordance with section 224 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

Mrs Taylor first acquired her Manager's Certificate in 2012.

In December 2015 Mrs Taylor successfully completed the Licence Controller Qualification Bridging Test. The LCQ Bridging Test is a requirement of all Manager's Certificates that are renewed for the first time under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, which was enacted on the 18th December 2012. The LCQ Bridging Test ensures that all applicants that acquired their Manager's Certificates under the previous Sale of Liquor Act 1989 have a solid understanding of the recent changes in the law governing the Sale and Supply of Alcohol within New Zealand. Mrs Taylor's successful completion of this test has reaffirmed her understanding of those changes and the legal requirements of her as a Certified Manager.

Mrs Taylor has worked within the hospitality industry for approximately 4 ½ years.

The Licensing Inspector has provided a report outlining the applicant's suitability and experience.

Neither the New Zealand Police nor the Licensing Inspector express any concern about the suitability of the applicant nor do they oppose the granting of the application.

DECISION

Under s224 the application and supporting information satisfies the Chairperson that the criteria we must have regard to as set out in s.227 of the Act have been met.

The District Licensing Committee Chairperson, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 **grants** an application by Celene Jade Vivienne Taylor (nee Howell) for the renewal of a Manager's Certificate (17/CERT/041/2015).

The certificate is valid for a period of three years from the date the certificate is issued.
