APPLICATION

This is an application by Jenny Kate Rhodes for the renewal of a manager's certificate in accordance with section 224 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

Mrs Rhodes successfully completed her Licence Controller Qualification in May 2014 supporting her knowledge and understanding of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and her initial Manager's Certificate in July 2014

Mrs Rhodes is currently a part owner and operator of The Wooden Farmer Cafe in Putaruru.

Prior to establishing The Wooden Farmer Mrs Rhodes gained experience at several different licensed premises. Mrs Rhodes now manages her own licensed restaurant "The Wooden Farmer", where she continues to gain experience.

Ms Rhodes continued involvement in the hospitality industry would suggest that the applicant continues to hold the necessary skills and knowledge to renew her Manager's Certificate.

South Waikato District Council has not received any information that may suggest otherwise in the past year since the initial granting of her Manager's Certificate.

The Licensing Inspector has provided a report outlining the applicant's suitability and experience and has tested their understanding of their responsibilities as a manager.

Neither the New Zealand Police nor the Licensing Inspector express any concern about the suitability of the applicant nor do they oppose the granting of the application.

DECISION

Under s224 the application and supporting information satisfies the Chairperson that the criteria we must have regard to as set out in s.227 of the Act have been met.

The District Licensing Committee Chairperson, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 **grants** an application Jenny Kate Rhodes for the renewal of a Manager's Certificate (17/CERT/033/2014).

The certificate is valid for a period of three years from the date the certificate is issued.
