## **APPLICATION**

This is an application by Jerusha Chanell Petley for a manager's certificate in accordance with section 219 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

The applicant is currently employed by Crown and Anchor Putaruru where she has worked for over six months.

The applicant has submitted a copy of her Licence Controller qualification course and NZQA Unit 4646 as well as Unit 16705.

In September 2015 Mrs Petley successfully completed the Licensed Controller Qualification demonstrating an understanding of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

## **REASONS FOR THE DECISION**

The applicant holds the Licensed Controller Qualification which she successfully completed in September 2015 demonstrating her understanding of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and also demonstrating knowledge of host responsibility requirements as a duty manager of licensed premises during her interview with the Liquor Licensing Inspector.

The Licensing Inspector has provided a report outlining the applicant's suitability in working in licensed premises and has tested their understanding of their responsibilities as a manager.

Neither the New Zealand Police nor the Licensing Inspector express any concern about the suitability of the applicant nor do they oppose the granting of the application.

No undertakings are sought by the agencies.

## **DECISION**

The application and supporting information satisfies the Chairperson that the criteria we must have regard to as set out in s.222 of the Act have been met.

The District Licensing Committee Chairperson, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 grants an application Jerusha Chanell Petley for a Manager's Certificate (17/CERT/017/2015).

The certificate is valid for a period of twelve months from the date the certificate is issued.
