**APPLICATION**

This is an application by Karuna Devi Singh for the renewal of a manager's certificate in accordance with section 224 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

Karuna Devi Singh and her husband previously owned and operated the Civic Dairy on Putaruru and also Value Liquor formerly called The Grog Shop.

Mrs Singh has held her manager's licence for ten years.

If Mrs Singh's manager's certificate renewal is successful she will be commencing work at the Okoroire Hotel.

Karuna Devi Singh has completed her Licensed Controller Certificate in March 2006 and has held her manager's certificate since May 2006.

Police do not oppose the application.

**REASONS FOR THE DECISION**

Karuna Devi Singh has completed her Licensed Controller Certificate in March 2006 and has held her manager's certificate since May 2006.

The Licensing Inspector has provided a report outlining the applicant's suitability and experience.

Neither the New Zealand Police nor the Licensing Inspector express any concern about the suitability of the applicant nor do they oppose the granting of the application.

Mrs Singh has held her manager's licence for ten years and it is reasonable to assume that Mrs Singh has gained the appropriate training and experience over the last ten years.


**DECISION**
