APPLICATION

This is an application by Sukhjinder Singh for the renewal of a manager's certificate in accordance with section 224 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

Mr Singh is currently employed by the Merchant of Tirau. Mr Singh has previously worked for Blackbull Liquor in Putaruru and prior to that Blackbull Liquor in Hamilton.

Mr Singh completed his Licence Controller Qualification in March 2006 and has held his manager's certificate since June 2012 which was issued by the South Waikato District Licensing Committee

Mr Singh has held his licence for nearly four years.

Police do not oppose the application.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

Mr Singh completed his Licence Controller Qualification in March 2006 and has held his manager's certificate since June 2012 which was issued by the South Waikato District Licensing Committee and would confirm his understanding of the current legislation governing the sale and supply of alcohol.

It is reasonable to assume that Mr Singh has gained the appropriate training and experience over the past four years.

The Licensing Inspector has provided a report outlining the applicant's suitability and experience.

Neither the New Zealand Police nor the Licensing Inspector express any concern about the suitability of the applicant nor do they oppose the granting of the application.

DECISION

Under s224 the application and supporting information satisfies the Chairperson that the criteria we must have regard to as set out in s.227 of the Act have been met.

The District Licensing Committee Chairperson, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 **grants** an application by Sukhjinder Singh for the renewal of a Manager's Certificate (17/CERT/078/2016).

The certificate is valid for a period of three years from the date the certificate is issued.
