APPLICATION

This is an application by Rawinia Kaiapu Keelan for a manager's certificate in accordance with section 219 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

The applicant is currently employed at the Trees Tavern in Tokoroa.

Ms Keelan has been employed at the Trees Tavern for over 6 months at the time of her Manager's Certificate application in September 2015.

The applicant successfully completed her Licensed Controller Qualification on the 2nd April 2015.

The Police do not oppose the application.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The applicant successfully completed her Licensed Controller Qualification on the 2nd April 2015 supporting her knowledge and understanding of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

Rawinia Kaiapu Keelan is currently employed at the Trees Tavern in Tokoroa.

Neither the South Waikato District Council nor the Police have received any negative feedback or information that would suggest that Rawinia Kaiapu Keelan is not suitable to hold a Manager's Certificate

The Licensing Inspector has provided a report outlining the applicant's suitability and experience and has tested their understanding of their responsibilities as a manager.

Neither the New Zealand Police nor the Licensing Inspector express any concern about the suitability of the applicant nor do they oppose the granting of the application.


DECISION
