APPLICATION

This is an application by Kamaldeep Singh for a manager's certificate in accordance with section 219 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

Kamaldeep Singh is currently employed at Liquor Hut Tokoroa. He has been working in this Off Licensed premises for approximately four (4) months.

The applicant successfully completed his Licence Controller Qualification in November 2015 demonstrating his knowledge of the requirements of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and its implications for licensed premises and his knowledge of host responsibility requirements as a duty manager of licensed premises.

Police do not oppose the application.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

Kamaldeep Singh has been working in an Off licensed premises for approximately four (4) months. He is currently employed at Liquor Hut Tokoroa.

Mr Singh has included two references with his application and both referees attest to his honesty and reliability.

The Licensing Inspector has provided a report outlining the applicant's suitability and experience and has tested their understanding of their responsibilities as a manager. She speaks of him being a highly motivated and intelligent individual who appears to hold the necessary attributes favourable in a Certified Manager.

Neither the New Zealand Police nor the Licensing Inspector express concern about the suitability of the applicant nor do they oppose the granting of the application.

DECISION

The application and supporting information satisfies the Chairperson that the criteria we must have regard to as set out in s.222 of the Act have been met.

The District Licensing Committee Chairperson, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 grants an application by Kamaldeep Singh for a Manager's Certificate (Ref: (17/CERT/044/2016)

The certificate is valid for a period of one year from the date the certificate is issued.
