APPLICATION

This is an application by Derek John Kelsen for the renewal of a manager's certificate in accordance with section 224 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

Derek John Kelsen is currently the manager of the Tirau Golf Club. He has held this position for almost five years. He has been a member of the Club for sixteen years.

Mr Kelsen completed a Licensed Controller Qualification Certificate in course March 2015. This is the applicant's first renewal application since being issued his manager's certificate in May 2015.

Police do not oppose the application.

The Licensing Inspector does not oppose the application.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

Derek John Kelsen has submitted a copy of his Licensed Controller Qualification certificate which demonstrates knowledge on the requirements of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and host responsibility.

During his time as a member of the Tirau Golf Club he has held various positions of responsibility including helping behind the bar and accordingly it would be reasonable to assume that Mr Kelsen has acquired experience in the sale and supply of alcohol.

The Licensing Inspector has provided a report outlining the applicant's suitability and experience.

Neither the New Zealand Police nor the Licensing Inspector express any concern about the suitability of the applicant nor do they oppose the granting of the application.

DECISION

Under s224 the application and supporting information satisfies the Chairperson that the criteria we must have regard to as set out in s.227 of the Act have been met.

The District Licensing Committee Chairperson, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 grants an application by Derek John Kelsen for the renewal of a Manager's Certificate (17/CERT/106/2015)

The certificate is valid for a period of three years from the date the certificate is issued.
