IN THE MATTER of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (The Act)

AND

IN THE MATTER of an application by Alicia Taylor pursuant to s138 and s142 of The Act for an On Site Special Licence in respect of premises situated at Junction Street, Putaruru and known as Putaruru College.

THE APPLICATION

Alicia Taylor on behalf of Putaruru College has applied for an on-site Special Licence in respect of premises situated at Junction Street Putaruru and known as Putaruru College.

The proposed event is the Senior A Netball Auction evening.

The event is to be held on Wednesday 11th May and will commence at 6:00pm and conclude at 9:30pm. The proposed event is to enable the Putaruru College Team to fundraise for their trip to Gold Coast, Australia. Proceeds go towards funding the tour.

The applicant has sought no designation on the event as the emphasis will not be on alcohol but on the fundraising auction.

Low alcohol and non-alcoholic refreshments will be provided. Drinking water will be available from the bar.

The applicant has advised that there will be a courtesy van available.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The applicant has previously operated Special Licences with no issues or concerns.

The applicant is fully aware of every requirement to ensure that attendees are in a controlled, safe and comfortable environment and it appears that the applicant has the appropriate training to comply with the law.

The applicant has stated that there will be at least nine adults monitoring the venue with at least one certified manager.

The applicant has sought no designation on the event as the emphasis will not be on alcohol but on the fundraising auction. As many of the team will be under eighteen (18) years and will be assisting with the auction I concur with the designation.

Hot meals and bar snacks will be available.

The report of the Inspector indicates that the amenity and good order of the locality will not be adversely affected by more than a minor extent.

Low alcohol and non alcoholic beverages will be available and water will be available free from the bar.

Neither the Police nor the Medical Officer of Health raises any matters in opposition.

A courtesy van will be available.

The Licensing Inspector Ms Kristina Moore does not oppose this application.

The South Waikato District Council does not currently have a Local Alcohol Policy.

I am satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s105 & s142 of the Act.

DECISION

The District Licensing Committee Chairperson, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 grants the application for an on-site Special Licence (application 17/SP/040/2016) by Alicia Taylor on behalf of Putaruru College in respect of premises situated at Junction Street Putaruru subject to the following conditions.

CONDITIONS


- 1 Alcohol may be sold and supplied under the licence only on the following day and during the following hours:

Wednesday 11th May commencing at 6:00pm and conclude at 9:30pm.

- 2 The designation for the entire premises will be **“Undesignated”**.
- 3 The entire premises shall be vacated by 10pm that being thirty (30) minutes after the time the premises is required to close for the sale of alcohol unless justified in accordance with s.255 of the Act.
- 4 Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
- 5 At all times when the premises is open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages must be available for consumption on the premises.
- 6 Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises is open for the sale and supply of alcohol.
- 6 One certified manager must be on duty at all times when the premises is open for the sale and supply of alcohol and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed at/in the premises.

- 8 At least nine (9) adults to be on duty for the event to ensure that people do not become intoxicated and to check ID to ensure that underage attendees are not served alcohol.
- 9 The licensee must provide information, advice and assistance about alternative forms of transport available to patrons from the licensed premises.
