THE APPLICATION

Rose Marriner on behalf of Southern United Rugby Football Club (SURF) has applied for an on-site Special Licence in respect of premises situated at 3-37 Mossop Road and known as Southern United Rugby Football Club (SURF).

The proposed event is a 21st birthday celebration for Ali Cowley.

The event is to be held on Saturday 14th May and will commence at 6:00pm and conclude at 1:00am the following day. The event will be supervised until 9:00pm and become restricted from 9:00pm until 1:00am the following day. There will be approximately one hundred people attending the event.

A full buffet menu will be provided for the event.

There will be three Certified Managers on duty throughout the event.

Low alcohol and non-alcoholic refreshments will be provided. Drinking water will be available from the bar.

The applicant has advised that there will be a courtesy van available.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The applicant has previously operated Special Licences.

The applicant is fully aware of every requirement to ensure that attendees are in a controlled, safe and comfortable environment and it appears that the applicant has the appropriate systems, staff and training to comply with the law.

The Licensing Inspector Ms Lily Li does not oppose this application.

Substantive food and free water will be available throughout all events.

The comprehensive report of the Inspector indicates that the amenity and good order of the locality will not be adversely affected by more than a minor extent.

Neither the Police nor the Medical Officer of Health raises any matters in opposition.

The South Waikato District Council does not currently have a Local Alcohol Policy.

I am satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s105 & s142 of the Act.

DECISION

The District Licensing Committee Chairperson, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 grants the application for an on-site Special Licence (application 17/SP/041/2016) by Rose Marriner on behalf of the Southern United Rugby Football Club (SURF) in respect of premises situated at 3-37 Mossop Road and known as Southern United Rugby Football Club (SURF) subject to the following conditions.

CONDITIONS

- 1 Alcohol may be sold and supplied under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:
- 2 The designation for the entire premises will be **"Supervised"** between the hours of 6:00pm and 9.00pm and from 9.00pm until 1:00am the following day the designation will become **"Restricted"**.
- 3 The entire premises shall be vacated within 30 minutes of closing time.
- 4 Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
- The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
- 6 Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol.
- 7 Two certificated managers must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed at/in the premises.
- 8 At least two Club members to be on duty for each of the events to ensure that people do not become intoxicated and to check ID to ensure that underage attendees are not served alcohol.
- The licensee must provide information, advice and assistance about alternative forms of transport available to patrons from the licensed premises.
