APPLICATION

- 1) This is an application by Alison Hinfelaar for the renewal of a manager's certificate in accordance with section 224 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
- 2) Alison Hinfelaar has held her manager's certificate since the year 2004.
- 3) Mrs Hinfelaar has been employed by Countdown Supermarket for approximately 24 years.
- 4) Mrs Hinfelaar completed her Licensed Controller Qualification in March 2006.
- 5) Mrs Hinfelaar completed her Licensed Controller Bridging Test in January 2014.
- 6) Police do not oppose the application.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

- 1) Alison Grace Hinfelaar completed her Licensed Controller Qualification in March 2006 and her Licensed Controller Bridging Test in January 2014.
- 2) Mrs Hinfelaar has held her manager's licence since 2004.
- 3) The Licensing Inspector has provided a report outlining the applicant's suitability and experience.
- 4) Neither the New Zealand Police nor the Licensing Inspector express any concern about the suitability of the applicant nor do they oppose the granting of the application.
- 5) Mrs Hinfelaar has held her manager's licence for twelve years but has over twenty (20) years experience in the supermarket industry and it is reasonable to assume that she has gained the appropriate training and experience over these years.

DECISION

- 6) Under s224 the application and supporting information satisfies the Chairperson that the criteria we must have regard to as set out in s.227 of the Act have been met.
- 7) The District Licensing Committee Chairperson, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 **grants** an application by Alison Grace Hinfelaar for the renewal of a Manager's Certificate (17/CERT/027/2016).

The certificate is valid for a period of three years from the date the certificate is issued.
