APPLICATION

- 1) This is an application by Gregory Pearce for the renewal of a manager's certificate in accordance with section 224 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
- 2) Gregory Pearce has held his manager's certificate since the year 2013.
- 3) Mr Pearce is a member of the Southern United Rugby Club in Tokoroa.
- 4) Mr Pearce completed his Licensed Controller Qualification in November 2011.
- 5) Mr Pearce is also a volunteer Fireman and has historically worked on an off-licence premises.
- 6) Police do not oppose the application.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION


- 1) Gregory Pearce completed his Licensed Controller Qualification in November 2011.
- 2) Mr Pearce has held his manager's licence since 2013.
- 3) The Licensing Inspector has provided a report outlining the applicant's suitability and experience.
- 4) Neither the New Zealand Police nor the Licensing Inspector express any concern about the suitability of the applicant nor do they oppose the granting of the application.
- 5) Mr Pearce has held his manager's licence for 3 years and it is reasonable to assume that he has gained the appropriate training and experience over these years.

DECISION

- 6) Under s224 the application and supporting information satisfies the Chairperson that the criteria we must have regard to as set out in s.227 of the Act have been met.
- 7) The District Licensing Committee Chairperson, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 **grants** an application by Gregory Pearce for the renewal of a Manager's Certificate (17/CERT/033/2016).

The certificate is valid for a period of three years from the date the certificate is issued.
