APPLICATION

- 1) This is an application by Tony Alan Hart for the renewal of a manager's certificate in accordance with section 224 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
- 2) Tony Alan Hart has held his manager's certificate since the year 2003.
- 3) Mr Hart was employed by the Tokoroa Cosmopolitan Club both as a duty manager and catering manager, employment that has recently ceased.
- 4) Mr Hart is in the process of setting up his own catering business.
- 5) Mr Hart completed his Licensed Controller Qualification in May 2007 and also the Licence Controller Qualification Bridging Test.
- 6) Police do not oppose the application.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

- 1) Tony Alan Hart completed his Licensed Controller Qualification in May 2007.
- 2) Mr Hart has held his manager's licence since 2003.
- 3) The Licensing Inspector has provided a report outlining the applicant's suitability and experience.
- 4) Neither the New Zealand Police nor the Licensing Inspector express any concern about the suitability of the applicant nor do they oppose the granting of the application.
- 5) Mr Hart has held his manager's licence for thirteen years and has a number of years experience working in the liquor industry and it is reasonable to assume that she has gained the appropriate training and experience over these years.

DECISION

- 6) Under s224 the application and supporting information satisfies the Chairperson that the criteria we must have regard to as set out in s.227 of the Act have been met.
- 7) The District Licensing Committee Chairperson, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 **grants** an application by Tony Alan Hart for the renewal of a Manager's Certificate (17/CERT/022/2016).

The certificate is valid for a period of three years from the date the certificate is issued.
