SPECIAL LICENCE

Special licence (for premises)

Sections 22, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **TWO BROTHERS WHOLESALE LIMITED** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at **1 Balmoral Drive, Tokoroa** and known as "**TREES TAVERN**" to any person attending the following event:

"NEW YEAR'S EVE BALL"

(Except where the District Licensing Committee grants an exemption under s213(2) of the Act) The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 6 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

1) Alcohol may be sold and supplied under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:

Sunday 31 December 2017	New Year's Eve Ball	100 +	8.00 pm to 1.30 am the following day

- 2) The entire premises is to be designated as "Restricted"
- 3) Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
- 4) The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
- 5) The full menu of food provided with the application must be available for consumption on the premises until 1.00 am and must be actively promoted.
- 6) The licensee must ensure that the special licence is visible to patrons and displayed at the principal entrance on the licensed area.
- 7) The licensee must provide information on alternative forms of safe transport for the attendees.
- 8) No sale of alcohol is to take place after the designated bar closing time.
- 9) The entire licensed area is to be vacated within 30 minutes of the bar closing as stated on the table above, unless that persons presence is justified, such as restocking and cleaning.
- 10) All off sales made to people who intend to stay in the bar, after 10.00 pm, must have the dated and timed receipt attached to it so that it is readable by the agencies if they so wish - and the alcohol is to be stored safely and only released by security of staff when the patron leaves.
- 11) That security and staff monitor the car park at all times to ensure that people are not consuming alcohol in their vehicles.
