THE APPLICATION:

Putāruru Bowling Club Limited has filed an application pursuant to s.127 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 for a Renewal of Club Licence in respect of the premises situated at 82 Arapuni Street, Putāruru.

The applicant is a club was incorporated under the Companies Act 1993 on the 2nd of May 1951.

The business is an established Club

There will be two certified managers employed.

The applicant seeks the following hours:

Monday to Sunday 8:30am - 9:30pm

The application was publicly notified in the South Waikato news on the 20th of April 2016 and the second was on the 27th of April 2016.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The application is complete and contains all the supporting documents as required under s.127 of the Act. It was duly advertised and no objection, opposition or notice of desire to be heard has been received.

The Licensing Inspector does not oppose this application.

The Police do not oppose this application.

The Medical Officer of Health does not oppose the application.

The Fire Risk Management Officer does not oppose this application.

The premises meets the requirements of the Resource Management Act 1991.

The premises meets the requirements of the Building Code.

The premises is "undesignated".

Currently the South Waikato does not have a Local Alcohol Policy.

The applicant duly advertised their intention to apply for an Club-licence

The application did not attract any public objections.

Overall I am satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.105

DECISION

The District Licensing Committee Chairperson, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **approves** an application by Putāruru Bowling Club Limited for a Renewal of Club Licence (17/CL/004/2016) in respect of premises situated at 82 Arapuni Street, Putāruru and known as Putāruru Bowling Club subject to the following conditions:

CONDITIONS

1) The following days and hours that alcohol can be sold and consumed on the premises are:

Monday to Sunday 8:30am to 9:30pm

- 2) Drinking water is to be freely available whilst the premises are open for business.
- 3) The following steps must be taken to promote the responsible consumption of alcohol:
 - (i) The licensee must ensure that all staff must comply with the host responsibility information submitted with the application for an on-licence detailing the steps to be taken by the licensee to ensure a safe drinking environment.
- 4) The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
 - (i) Ensure that no intoxicated persons are allowed to enter or to remain on the premises.
 - (ii) Ensure that appropriate signs are prominently displayed detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of liquor to minors and intoxicated persons adjacent to every point of sale.
- 5) A duty manager register pursuant to Section 232 must be kept on the premises and maintained.
- 6) A Certificated Manager or duly appointed Temporary or Acting Manager must be on duty and responsible for compliance at all times the Club is open for the sale and supply of alcohol.
- 7) The entire premises is "Undesignated"
- 8) The licence is issued for three years and can be issued immediately.
