**THE DECISION**

As there were no matters raised in opposition to the granting of this licence, the application is dealt with on the papers. The District Licensing Committee was satisfied as to the criteria to which they must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act and your Special Licence has been granted.

**CONDITIONS**

1. Alcohol may be sold and supplied under the licence only on the following day and during the following hours:  
**Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> November 2017 from 7:00pm — 02:00am the next day**
2. The proposed designation for the event is as follows - That the premises are "Restricted" between 7.00pm to 02:00am the next day.
3. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
4. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
5. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol.

6. The licensee must provide information, advice and assistance about alternative forms of transport available to patrons from the licensed premises.
7. The premises must be vacated within 30 minutes of the stated finishing time unless an individual's presence on the premises is justifiable pursuant to Section 255(4) of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
