THE APPLICATION:

An application was received from **CHARNJIT SINGH** pursuant to s.100 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 for an Off-licence in respect of premises situated at 37 Main Road, Tirau trading as **"BREWS TIRAU"**.

The applicant is a natural person

The business is a stand-alone off licence.

There will be at least 4 persons employed.

The applicant seeks the following hours:

Monday to Sunday – 8.30 am to 10.00 pm

The application was publicly notified in the South Waikato News on 19 December 2018 and 16 January 2019.

An onsite notice was posted.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The application is complete and contains all the supporting documents as required under s.100 of the Act. It was duly advertised and no objection, opposition or notice of desire to be heard has been received.

The Licensing Inspector does not oppose this application.

The Police do not oppose this application.

The Medical Officer of Health does not oppose the application.

The premises meets the requirements of the Resource Management Act 1991.

The premise meets the requirements of the Building Code.

The premises is designated "Supervised" which is appropriate for this type of business.

No objections were received as the result any advertisement placed.

DECISION

The District Licensing Committee Chairperson, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, approves the application subject to the following conditions:

CONDITIONS

- 1) No alcohol is to be sold on the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1.00pm on Anzac Day to any person.
- 2) The following days and hours that alcohol can be sold and consumed on the premises are:

Monday to Sunday – 8.30 am to 10.00 pm

- 3) The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of liquor to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated person
- 4) There will be no single sales of Ready to Drinks (RTD's) or mainstream beer in either bottles or cans; and no sales of single shots.
