DECISION

BEFORE THE SOUTH WAIKATO DISTRICT LICENSING CHAIRPERSON

APPLICATION

This is an application by Harpreet SINGH SIDHU for the renewal of Manager's Certificate in accordance with section 224 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

The applicant has submitted a copy of his Licence Controller qualification certificate which includes NZQA Units 4646 and 16705.

The applicant has held a certificate for one year and is currently working at a licensed premises.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The applicant holds the Licence Controller Qualification.

The Licensing Inspector has provided a report outlining the applicant's suitability and experience in controlling licensed premises; has tested their understanding of their responsibilities as a manager and currently work in a licensed premises.

Neither the New Zealand Police nor the Licensing Inspector express any concern about the suitability of the applicant nor do they oppose the granting of the application.

The Inspector sought the following undertaking: -

"I recommend that the renewal of manager's certificate application is granted and issued for 3 years with an expiry date of 15 February 2022 but is subject to the applicant providing the South Waikato District Council on or before 22 December 2020 an updated immigration status whether that be either an extended Visa, Permanent Residency or a New Zealand Passport if indeed the applicant still resides in this area"

DECISION

The application and supporting information satisfies the Chairperson and the criteria we must have regard to as set out in s.227 of the Act have been met.

The District Licensing Committee Chairperson, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 grants this renewal and supports the inspector's undertaking

I recommend that the renewal of manager's certificate application is granted and issued for 3 years with an expiry date of 15 February 2022 but is subject to the applicant providing the South Waikato District Council on or before 22 December 2020 an updated immigration status whether that be either an extended Visa, Permanent Residency or a New Zealand Passport if indeed the applicant still resides in this area.
