BEFORE THE SOUTH WAIKATO DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE

TOKOROA SQUASH CLUB INCORPORATED applies for a renewal of the CLUB Licence in respect of premises situated at 7 East Parkdale Street, Tokoroa and known as "**TOKOROA SQUASH CLUB.**"

The applicant seeks to renew the existing licensed days and hours of:

Monday to Sunday 9.00am to 1.00am the following day;

The application was publicly notified in the South Waikato News on the 17th of April 2019 and no objections were received from the public.

The Club has a good range of food options and low and non-alcoholic beverages available at all times.

Neither the reports of the Police nor that of the Medical Officer of Health raises any matters in opposition and the applicant has not come to the attention of reporting agencies during the renewal period.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

Neither the Police nor the Medical Officer of Health have raised any matters in opposition.

The inspector reports that the amenity and good order of the area has not been adversely affected by more than a minor extent. The Club has sound host responsibility practices and operates within their principal purpose.

Overall, I am satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act.

We refresh the conditions to align with best practice and the new Act.

DECISION

The District Licensing Committee Chairman, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **approves** an application by **Tokoroa Squash Club Incorporated** for a renewal of the CLUB Licence in respect of premises situated at 7 East Parkdale Street, Tokoroa and known as **Tokoroa Squash Club**” subject to conditions.


The renewal will be for three years from the expiry of the current licence and a replacement licence is to be issued.

Conditions:

The licence is subject to following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold or supplied for consumption on the premises but only on the following days and hours:
Monday to Sunday 9.00am to 1.00am the following day;
2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises;
3. While the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol no BYO alcohol may be consumed on the premises.
4. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
5. At all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol a range of substantive food must be readily available. A minimum of three types of food should be available. Menus must be visible, and food should be actively promoted.
6. The licensee must provide information, advice and assistance about alternative forms of transport available to patrons from the licensed premises.
7. Alcohol can be sold and supplied to guests of members of clubs with which the licensee has an arrangement for reciprocal visiting rights for members
8. The Licensee must display:
 - a. At every point of sale, signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the inside of the premises so as to be easily read by persons using the premises.
