THE APPLICATION:

The Partnership of Lucas William CURRIE and Janice Lorrie CURRIE filed an application pursuant to s.100 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 for an On-licence in respect of premises situated at 31B Main Road Tirau trading as "**TUCKER BAR & EATERY**".

The applicant is a partnership

The business is a new café/restaurant.

There will be at least two certificated managers employed.

The applicant seeks the following hours:

- Monday to Sunday 7:00am to 12 midnight

The application was publicly notified in the South Waikato News on 28 August and 4 September 2019.

An onsite notice was posted on 23 August 2019

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The application is complete and contains all the supporting documents as required under s.100 of the Act. It was duly advertised and no objection, opposition or notice of desire to be heard has been received.

The Licensing Inspector does not oppose this application.

The Police do not oppose this application.

The Medical Officer of Health does not oppose the application.

The premises meets the requirements of the Resource Management Act 1991.

The premise meets the requirements of the Building Code.

The premises is undesignated which is appropriate for this type of business.

Currently the South Waikato does not have a Local Alcohol Policy.

No objections were received as the result any advertisement placed.

Overall I am satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.105

DECISION

The District Licensing Committee Chairperson, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, approves the application subject to the following conditions:

CONDITIONS

- 1) No alcohol is to be sold on the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1.00pm on Anzac Day to any person who is not present on the premises to dine.
- 2) The following days and hours that alcohol can be sold and consumed on the premises are:

Monday to Sunday 7:00 am to 12:00 midnight

- 3) Drinking water is to be freely available, and free of charge whilst the premises are open for business.
- 4) The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
 - (i) Ensure that no intoxicated persons are allowed to enter or to remain on the premises.
 - (ii) Ensure that appropriate signs are prominently displayed detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of liquor to minors and intoxicated persons adjacent to every point of sale.
- 5) There must be a properly certificated manager or duly appointed manager on the premises at all times the premises is open for the sale and supply of alcohol
- 6) A duty manager register pursuant to Section 232 must be kept on the premises and maintained.
- 7) The licence is issued for one year and can issue immediately.
