This is an application by <u>PAVSHAB LIMITED</u> for a Temporary Authority for premises situated at 79 Princes Street, Putaruru and known as the "<u>PUTARURU PUBLIC BAR</u>"

The business is a high-risk tavern and an ON Licence, 17/ON/007/2020, is operative at the premises and expires on the 14th day of September 2021.

The application contains supporting documentary evidence showing a signed off sale and purchase agreement and there are reports from the Police and the Inspector that do not raise any matters in opposition.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

Neither the New Zealand Police nor the Licensing Inspector oppose the granting of the order.

The Police do ask though, how the applicant intends to manage all the premises that they currently own. The applicant advises that he does have sufficient certificated staff to cover all hours at all premises.

We remind the applicant that the current licence carries a designation of Restricted Area. That means no one under the age of 18 years is permitted in the licensed area. This must be strictly enforced.

We note that the substantive ON licence application has been lodged.

Subject to the above, the application will be dealt with by the committee on the papers.

DECISION

The application and supporting information satisfies us that the criteria we must have regard to, as set out in s.136 of the Act, has been met.

The District Licensing Committee, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 makes an order for a Temporary Authority to PAVSHAB LIMITED and it can be issued immediately.

The conditions attached to ON LICENCE 17/ON/007/2020 shall continue to apply with the following additions/modifications:

- 1. An <u>experienced certificated manager must be on duty</u> at all times when the premises is open for the sale and supply of alcohol.
- 2. The whole of the premises is designated as a Restricted Area.

The Order is to run for 8 weeks from the 19th of July 2021 expiring on the 14th of September 2021
