THE APPLICATION

TOKOROA HOST LIONS CHARITABLE TRUST applies for an on-site Special Licence in respect of premises situated at Mossop Road known as the South Waikato Events Centre to host the annual Calf Day Charity Dinner and the Lions Convention in 2021. Up to 200 persons will attend the event.

The day and hours sought are:

Monday the 28th of November 2022 from 6.00pm to 10.30pm.

Substantive food and low alcohol and non-alcoholic beverages will be available at all times.

THE REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The Inspector has provided a report on the application and believes the application meets the criteria for issue.

The Club seeks an exemption from having a certificated manager to oversee the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol at these functions. We agree that the events should be of low risk and grant the exemption

Neither the Police nor the Medical Officer of Health raise any matters in opposition.

I am satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act.

DECISION

The District Licensing Committee, pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 **grants** the application by **TOKOROA HOST LIONS CHARITABLE TRUST** for an on-site Special Licence in respect of premises situated at Mossop Road known as the **South Waikato Events Centre** subject to conditions.


Conditions:

The licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold and supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:
Monday the 28th of November 2022 from 6.00pm to 10.30pm.
 2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises;
 3. A person, nominated by the licensee to be responsible for the conduct of the premises, must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol;
 4. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence or menu variations of a similar range and standard;
 5. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages;
 6. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
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- a. At every point of sale detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
 - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
7. The licensee must provide information and advice about forms of transport available to patrons from the licensed premises.
8. No BYO alcohol is to be brought into the event.
