The business is a low-risk restaurant and an ON Licence, 17/ON/018/2021, is operative at the premises and expires on the 20<sup>th</sup> of June 2024.

The first application contained supportive documentary evidence showing a lease agreement and a signed S&P agreement.

## REASONS FOR THE DECISION

We are advised that the substantive applications have now been lodged and are being processed.

The TA will carry conditions to ensure compliance with the Act.

We are sure the Police and the Inspectorate will conduct unannounced compliance checks to ensure the conditions of the Order are being complied with at all times.

Any breaches will be dealt with firmly and swiftly.

Subject to the above, the application will be dealt with by the committee on the papers.

## **DECISION**

The application and supporting information (subject to the above) satisfies us that the criteria we must have regard to as set out in s.136 of the Act, has been met.

The District Licensing Committee, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 makes an order for a Temporary Authority to **OMAX ENTERPRISES LIMITED** and it can be issued immediately.

The conditions attached to ON LICENCE 17/ON/018/2021 shall continue to apply with the following additions/modifications:

- 1. An experienced <u>certificated manager</u> <u>must</u> be on duty at all times when the premises is open for the sale and supply of alcohol.
- 2. The applicant must supply a written roster of the weekly staff, and certificated manager appointments, every Monday morning to the Inspector.
- 3. The licensed hours of operation are reduced to 11.00am to 8.00pm each day.

The Order is to run for <u>3 months from the 7<sup>th</sup> of October 2022 until 7<sup>th</sup> of</u> January 2023
